Highlights on Code Enforcement

Larry Gursslin and Paul Hennekey are our Board appointed Code Enforcement Officers. These officers work closely with residents prior to and during construction ensuring that structures are built to comply with New York State and local building standards. These gentlemen interpret the zoning regulations and fairly apply them to property owners. Larry and Paul urge you to contact them with any questions you have regarding your plans to improve your property.

Code Enforcement also regulates the number of unregistered vehicles allowed per tax parcel. Tickets are issued to uncooperative residents. The Kendall Court, working with these residents, has been able to avoid issuing fines when a schedule for cleanup is established and adhered to.

Regarding the unsightly-burned homes around town, Code Enforcement is again utilizing the court system to keep property owners focused on the demolition and removal of these structures. This process has been complicated by the involvement of many different agencies. All agencies are now satisfied and the demolition can proceed. Watch for action on these properties!
