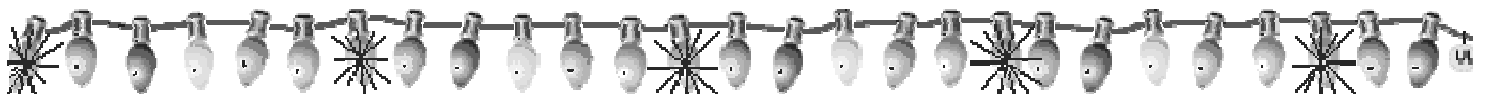

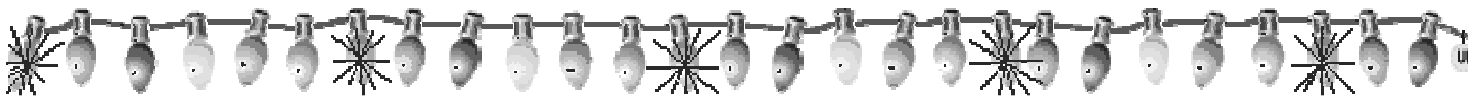
### Free Child Sitting Day

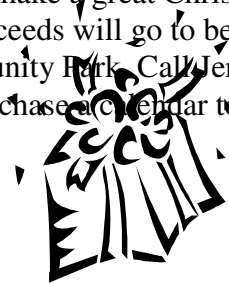
