








Guide to Successful Recycling

RECYCLABLES	PLACE IN RECYCLE BIN	PLACE IN TRASH
 <p>Glass</p>	<p>All clear, green and brown food and beverage containers ONLY. Remove and recycle all plastic & metal caps and lids. Labels do not have to be removed. Do not place in Plastic Bag.</p>	<p>Ceramic items, flowerpots, crystal, light bulbs, mirrors, ovenware and window glass</p>
 <p>Metal/Aluminum</p>	<p>All rinsed metal and aluminum food and beverage containers and aluminum food trays. Remove and recycle all plastic & metal caps and lids. Labels do not have to be removed. Do Not Place in Plastic Bag</p>	<p>Paint cans, automotive parts, pipe, gutters, pots and pans, toys and silverware.</p>
 <p>Paper</p>	<p>Everything that comes with your newspaper and all magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper and telephone books. Placing in a paper bags are helpful. Do Not Place in Plastic Bag</p>	<p>Pizza boxes, waxed board, hard cover books, tissue paper, napkins, wrapping paper, any food-soiled paper.</p>
 <p>Cardboard</p>	<p>All brown cardboard and all brown paper bags. Boxboard such as cereal, shoe and gift boxes. Flatten boxes into a section no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet. No Pizza Boxes</p>	<p>Wax coated, soiled boxes, cardboard lined with foam or laminated material. Frozen food boxes. Pizza boxes, fast food, beer & pop cases.</p>
 <p>#'s 1-7 Plastic</p>	<p>Empty and rinsed milk jugs, beverage containers, juice boxes, windshield washer fluid, detergent, bleach, butter, yogurt, cool whip, cottage cheese and plant pot containers, flip top lids and gable top milk and juice cartons. Flatten jugs if possible. Remove and recycle all plastic & metal caps and lids. Do Not Place In Plastic Bags.</p>	<p>Empty anti-freeze, motor oil containers. Plates, tableware, toys, medicine bottles or Tupperware. Deli containers. Plastic bags return to Wegmans or Tops</p>

In Fall 2009, Modern will change to "Single Stream" recycling technology. "Single Stream" recycling is the latest technology for collecting and processing recyclables. Residents will enjoy an expanded list of acceptable items for recycling and a simpler program because less material preparation is required. "Single Stream" recycling improves participation rates and communities should see a decreased in the amount of waste disposed of each year.
