## SUPERVISOR'S REMARKS

The purpose of tonight's Special Meeting is to receive the 2013 Tentative Budget. Worksheets were distributed by September 1<sup>st</sup>, and Department Heads had them back to budget officer (Supervisor Gaesser) by September 20<sup>th</sup>. The tentative budget was compiled as submitted from department heads, unadjusted. This was then filed with the Town Clerk on September 29<sup>th</sup>. This must be presented by October 5<sup>th</sup>, so tonight's meeting will meet that requirement. The Preliminary Budget Hearing has been scheduled for October 30<sup>th</sup>. It will be advertised for two consecutive weeks prior to that. The Board will accept the 2013 Preliminary Budget at its regular meeting on October 16<sup>th</sup>.

Deputy Clerk Bakutis presented the 2013 tentative budget to the town board for review.

## BUDGET DISCUSSION

Supervisor Gaesser:

- The 2% property tax cap is still in effect. The budget appropriation is at an increase of 1.01%. A flat 4.4229 tax rate is reflected. Assessment of the town went up, in good part due to the Salvation Army Camp being back to taxable status.
- Raises were discussed.
- Explanations of changes in budget lines were explained.
- Medical benefit numbers are not yet available.
- Went through a section by section review of the tentative budget.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

Joyce Henry asked about the State Aid, member item.

Supervisor Gaesser said the Energy Grant and Justice Court Security Assistance are included.

Al Lofthouse pointed out some errors in numbers on the budget and asked for clarification on some lines. Supervisor Gaesser thanked Mr. Lofthouse and will correct the errors, and answered the questions.

Councilman Pritchard motioned for adjournment, seconded by Councilman Schuth; all ayes, special meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
