APPROVAL OF MINUTES

CEO Report

Paul Gray discussed the possibility of a home being built in Kendall. Discussion took place about the windmill being constructed in Kendall. Paul said the land for the windmill had been purchased and met all the requirements issued by the planning board. He also said the building permit for the windmill had been requested. Dave discussed work the code enforcement office was doing with the assessor to close outstanding building permits. Discussion took place about permit fees. informal opinion. Paul discussed a referral regarding the Town of Medina. He said that Medina is looking to make the town more attractive to businesses by enhancing the corridor and instituting commercial design standards. Paul suggested that the board read the county planning board minutes.

MORATORIUM

Paul Gray passed out updated drafts on the moratorium for Hamlets, Waterfront Development and Waterfront Residential Zones. A work session began on the moratorium. Paul said that a joint workshop with the town board on the moratorium would occur February 1, 2011 at 7:30 p.m.

Discussion took place about the Junk Ordinance and the progress of the document.
