SUPERVISOR’S REMARKS

Board of Assessment Review has a vacancy, which will be filled by resolution tonight.

Szozda made the following motion, seconded by Flow:

RESOLUTION 63-0517 APPOINTING DONALD G. MANN TO THE BOARD OF ASSESSMENT REVIEW

Whereas there is currently a vacancy on the Board of Assessment Review, and

Whereas Donald G. Mann, 2143 Kendall Road, Kendall, NY, has declared interest in being appointed to the Kendall Board of Assessment Review and is able to attend the necessary training, so

Therefore, be it resolved to appoint Donald G. Mann to the Kendall Board of Assessment Review, effective immediately, and with his term of office to expire on September 30, 2021.

Discussion: Assessor Massey is comfortable with this choice, and Councilwoman Flow knows Mr. Mann and recommends his appointment.

Supervisor Cammarata called for a vote, resulting in all ayes, and declared the motion carried.

Topics of discussion:

SOLAR CODE – a final draft (4/17/17) was presented to the Supervisor and Councilman Newell by the Planning Board. Copies were made for the others and the Clerk.

A long, section by section review was completed. Many corrections, deletions, additions and clarifications were suggested.

The Clerk asked the Board if its members are pro or con industrial solar energy in general, to be able to pass that along to inquiring constituents, and to aid in the writing of this code, as to restrictiveness. The unanimous response was “pro”, but with protective restrictions. The current draft may be too restrictive.

Soliciting public comment from a wide array of residents before more time is spent on the writing of this legislation or a formal hearing is prudent.

SPECIAL USE PERMITS – a system needs to be put into place to keep track of upcoming renewals.

MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE – preparations in place

CURRENT STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO LAKE LEVEL – will be a long-term
problem; new information/changes daily
