MBC Country Mouse follows the Kendall

CURRICULUM

Daily schedules are designed to
encourage learning, independence,
socialization, creativity, and
self esteem.

The curriculum for our daily
programs is designed to be a positive
first learning experience. Emphasis is
placed on social development as your
child learns to work and play with a
group of his/her peers. Students are
given the opportunity to experience a
variety of creative activities (painting,
cutting, clay play), singing, story, and
show n' share circle times, large muscle
activities, sand table and free play.

In addition, our program strives
to help your child with pre- kindergarten
readiness skills. Activities are provided
to allow growth in fine motor skills,
listening skills, language development,
and pre-reading skills. The love of reading
is encouraged by daily story times, and by
our take home a library book program.
Creative art activities, cooking, singing,
group games are frequently planned.
Social development continues to be
fostered as opportunities are given to
work and play with others.

in Early Childhood Education.

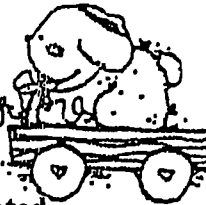
EVENTS
