SUPERVISOR’S REMARKS

This resolution is a step to the next potential water district. Things are moving along and look promising.

RESOLUTION

Councilwoman Flow made the following motion, which was seconded by Councilman Bnetley:

**RESOLUTION 54-0425 KENDALL WATER BENEFIT AREA 11 PROJECT:  
SEQR RESOLUTION – INTENT TO DECLARE LEAD AGENCY STATUS**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) regulations, the Town Board of the Town of Kendall hereby announces its intent to serve as Lead Agency to conduct an environmental review to extend public water service in a designated Water Benefit Area to residents who currently depend on individual wells with insufficient supply and poor water quality. The Town intends to seek funding assistance through the USDA Rural Development and EFC Drinking Water State Revolving Fund for this project.

**RESOLVED**, that the project involves installing approximately 70,000 linear feet of new water main along portions of Center Road, Lakeshore Road, Roosevelt Highway, Woodchuck Alley, Town Section, and Norway Road across 231 tax parcels. The project also includes installing approximately 160 fire hydrants, 85 valves, water services and associated surface restoration. The water main will be installed by open cut and directional drill methods. Fire hydrants will be installed every 500 feet along the water main: and proposed valves will be installed every 1,000 feet along the water

main and at intersections. The proposed ground disturbance is 8.8 acres. Disturbed areas will be restored in kind.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board has determined that the proposed action is an Unlisted action as defined under SEQR; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board has commissioned LaBella Associates DPC, to prepare Part 1 of the Environmental Assessment Form regarding the project.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board will complete a coordinated review and notify the involved agencies of its intention to act as the Lead Agency for this project and will provide them with a copy of the completed Part 1 of the environmental assessment form for review during the 30-day comment period.

Supervisor Cammarata called for a vote, which resulted in all ayes, and declared the motion carried.

With no further business being brought before the Board, Councilwoman Flow made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Councilman Gaudio; all were in favor. Supervisor Cammarata adjourned the meeting at 7:06 p.m.
