


Electrical Requirements for Grinder Pump Installation & Panel

1. Electrical Service

A) The new Grinder Pump control panel requires a dedicated 30A/240V circuit. Within 60 days after the alarm panel installation, a dedicated 30A/2P circuit breaker must be provided in the electrical panel, and a feeder using four #10 wires (L1, L2, neutral, and ground) must be connected to supply power to the grinder pump control panel.

B) Terminations in the control box are required to come through the bottom of the control panel.

2. Inspection Required

The electrical work must be inspected by a licensed electrical inspector. The Town recognizes the following agencies:

3. Submit Inspection Report
